The Kovach Kids

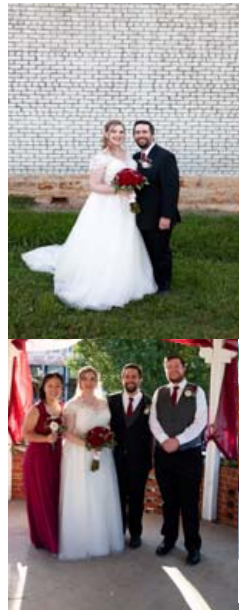
On September 24th, the oldest Kovach kid, Phillip married the love of his life Katie!
